**Invitation to an expert workshop on
“Visions of eGovernment in 2020”**

in conjunction with the 19th Bled eConference „eValues“, 6th June 2006

Dear expert!

The research group ‚eGovernment‘ located at the University of Koblenz-Landau, Institute for IS research, coordinates a research project named eGovRTD2020. It is co-funded by the EU under the 6th framework programme of IST. The project aims to identify future strategic research fields for the development of eGovernment. The methodology consists of both scenario building and road mapping. On the one hand visions will be described by scenarios for 2020 which details administration, policy, society and economics, as well as the interaction based on modern information and communication technology. On the other hand a action guideline for eGovernment research programmes will suggest based on the scenario building results. Both the scenarios and the roadmap will developed with assistance of regional distributed workshops in different European member states.

The objective target of the first round of regional workshops is to build up visions and images administration, policy, society and information technology. Particular attention shall be given to how aktors of administration, policy, society will communicate during public performance building, decision making and interaction with assistanceof modern, innovative information technology in future. Additionally questions will asked about the perception of public services, the importance of public values and how they will look like.

At the scenario building workshops small groups of experts shall build up the following questions on the basis of different scenarios:

- How will administration looks like in 2020?
- What kind of services will be provided by the public administration?
- Which values will coin society in regard to its expectations of the public administration?

- Which technologies will be deployed to process the tasks of public administration and to contact with its customers and society?
- Which structures and concepts administration and policy will use in 2020?

In a last common finishing round the likelihood of transformation these visions of 2020 will be assessed.

For that purpose we want to invite you to the workshop held in Bled at the Hotel Golf, room Libertas on 6th June 2006 at 14.00 – 17.30. Please find attached the provisional agenda of this workshop.
